Requirements:

- 1. Families must complete online variable Tuition Application from Smart Aid (www.smartaidforparents.com).
- Request an official school transcript sent to the "Anna and Harold Paige Scholarship Committee," c/o Montgomery Catholic Preparatory School 5350 Vaughn Road Montgomery, AL 36116

Currently enrolled MCPS student transcripts will be provided by the campus office after the completed application is turned in.

- 3. Secure three (3) letters of recommendation from teachers, coaches/club advisors or pastors/ministers.
- 4. St. Bede students in Grades 2-6 must include a paragraph to the committee answering the following question:

Why is winning this award important to you?"

5. High School applicants must submit an essay to the committee answering the following question:

Why is winning this award important to you?

- 6. Complete the scholarship application.
- 7. Submit completed application packet to the Business Office by the end of school day March 1.



Anna and Harold Paige Scholarship

About the Scholarship:

The Anna and Harold Paige Scholarship was established in 2013 by a generous donation to Montgomery Catholic Preparatory School by the estate of Anna and Harold Paige, who were faithful members of St. Bede the Venerable Catholic Church. The Anna and Harold Paige Scholarship is an annual, non-denominational, need based, scholarship to be awarded to one Montgomery Catholic Preparatory School High School student and one St. Bede Elementary Campus student. Qualified students will demonstrate good moral character and leadership qualities.

Amount of Award:

The Anna and Harold Paige Scholarship is awarded annually and provides full tuition for one full school year for one (1) High School Campus student and one (1) St. Bede Elementary Campus student at Montgomery Catholic Preparatory School. It does not include registration fees, books, or endowment fee. It is not transferable. If a scholarship recipient leaves Montgomery Catholic Preparatory School for any reason prior to the completion of the award year, the unused portion of the award will revert back to the fund account.

Qualifications for this Scholarship:

For the purpose of this scholarship, the criteria are:

- 1. The family demonstrated financial need.
- 2. The student is new or currently enrolled for the fall in grades 9-12 or K5-6 at MCPS's St. Bede Elementary Campus.
- 3. The student exhibits positive Christian characteristics.
- 4. The student indicates a serious commitment to learning.
- 5. The student demonstrates good moral character and leadership qualities.

Selection Committee:

A committee comprised of the Montgomery Catholic Preparatory School President, High School Principal, two (2) faculty members, one (1) athletic coach, will make the final selection for the award. Subsequent vacancies on the committee are to be filled by committee vote.

Application Deadline: March 1

Announcement of the Award: The recipient of the Anna and Harold Paige Scholarship will be announced at the scholarship breakfast in May.
