Requirements:

4. Complete a 150-word essay, explaining why winning the scholarship is important.
5. Submit the completed application packet to the Business Office by the end of the school day March 1.

About the Scholarship:

This scholarship honors the memory of Jan Martin Mastin, Montgomery Catholic High School alumni, class of 1973. Jan was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother. She worked as a Registered Nurse (RN), Childbirth Educator and Pediatric Nurse Practitioner (PNP) and was committed to helping and serving others. Her Catholic education provided the foundation for academic success and strong religious values throughout her life. These scholarships honor her legacy by providing financial assistance to two deserving students who are seeking a Catholic education.

This scholarship is established through the benefaction of Jan's husband Hervey Mastin (CHS 1974) and their three daughters, and augmented by gifts from alumni, family, and friends of the school. It is our donors' intent to give Middle School and High School families the opportunity to attend our school, particularly those who could not otherwise afford it.

Amount of Award:

This scholarship will fund two tuition scholarships of \$2,000 each. If a scholarship recipient leaves Montgomery Catholic Preparatory School for any reason prior to the completion of the award year, the unused portion of the award will revert to the fund account.

Qualifications for this Scholarship:

To this scholarship, the criteria are:

1. The family demonstrates financial need.
2. The students are enrolled for the fall in grades 6-8 and 9-12, respectively.
3. The students exhibits positive Christian values and characteristics.
4. The students indicate a serious commitment to learning.
5. The recipients agree to write a letter of thanks to the major benefactors of this scholarship, if chosen.
6. Student must exhibit a strong academic record (if applicable) or potential for academic growth.
7. Student (and family) must be committed to the core values and mission of Montgomery Catholic Preparatory School, including active participation in the school community.
8. Student must be a practicing Catholic (student and/or family).

Selection Committee:

The selection committee is composed of long-term faculty members of the school with school administration.

Application Deadline: March 1. This includes the completed application and the financial aid assessments required for all scholarships at MCPS.

Announcement of Award:

The recipient of the Jan Martin Mastin Scholarship will be announced at the scholarship breakfast in May.
