POST GRADUATE: Approximately 95% of our graduates attend college, the majority of whom receive scholarships to the school of their choice.

Our High School campus serves students in grades 9-12, offering a college preparatory academic program with options in Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) classes. In addition, our campus features marching, concert and jazz bands, a full athletic program under the auspices of the Alabama High School Athletic Association (AHSAA), and an array of student clubs and service organizations.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Tutorials | Offered Monday through Thursday for 30 minutes after dismissal. It is time for students to get additional help from teachers and ask specific questions.

Service | Service is a part of who we are as a school community and is integrated into the curriculum. We host at least one school-wide service day where all high school students serve at various sites in our community. Students also volunteer as tutors and help with campus projects and events. With our Encounter program, each week a small group of high school students volunteer at the Children's Center to serve children with special needs.

Class Retreats | Seniors take time to bond and form lasting friendships at their 2 day overnight retreat at Camp Chandler early in the school year. Our Campus Ministry program offers a Fall and Spring retreat for all high school students at the Holy Spirit Hall in Baldwin County. Worship nights are held on campus in the Fall and Spring. These are an opportunity for fun, fellowship, and faith.

Band | Our award winning and state recognized Band program features the Marching Knights, concert and jazz bands. Almost 20% of our student body participates in the band program!

House System | Our High School House program was established in the fall of 2022 to encourage community across grade levels and intentionally foster relationships between students and faculty. It offers opportunities for students to work, play, worship, and serve with students and faculty they may not have known prior. The ultimate goal is to broaden and continue cultivating the family culture that Montgomery Catholic is known for.

STEM | Our dedicated Maker's Space features laser cutters, 3D printers, CAD programs, VEX Robotics, a flight simulator, and more! We also offer a Broadcasting elective course (and classroom!) for students who want to be involved in videography. They can get involved with editing, lighting, sound, graphics, or be on-air talent.

Athletics | We compete in AHSAA athletics. We currently have 10 boy's and 10 girl's sports. Our gym houses a state of the art weight room, locker rooms, and equipment rooms.

Extracurriculars | Marching Knights, Concert Band, Jazz Band, Choir, Drama, CyberPatriots, Youth Legislature, Youth in Judicial, Young Women's Leadership, Pro-Life Club, VEX Robotics, Maker's Space, SGA, and MORE!



FAITH FORMATION

Theology class is taught every day and is considered a core subject. Each campus attends weekly Mass, First Friday Mass, and Holy Days of Obligation. For Catholic students, we offer sacramental preparation for Confirmation in 11th grade.

Campus Ministry is a way to bring the faith alive for all students. In addition to mass, there are daily confessions and weekly adoration as well as school-wide retreats, worship nights, bible studies, and more!

Our wonderful local parochial vicars and parish priests visit with our students regularly and are a beloved part of our campus community. It is normal to see our priests playing sports, hosting bible study, and hanging around campus.
