SPECIAL EVENTS

ATHLETICS & CLUBS

Montgomery Catholic is a member of the Alabama High School Athletic Association. Middle school students may participate in a full offering of athletic teams at the middle school, junior varsity, or varsity level in baseball, basketball, cheerleading, cross country, football, golf, indoor & outdoor track, soccer, softball, tennis, volleyball, and wrestling.

There is a variety of extracurricular activities and clubs available for middle school students, including Knight Ambassadors, Student Government Association, CyberPatriot, Math Counts, Junior Youth Legislature, and our awardwinning VEX Robotics and band programs.

FAITH FORMATION

Theology class is taught everyday in grades K3-12th grades, and is considered one of the core subjects. Each campus attends weekly Mass, First Friday Mass, and Holy Days of Obligation.
