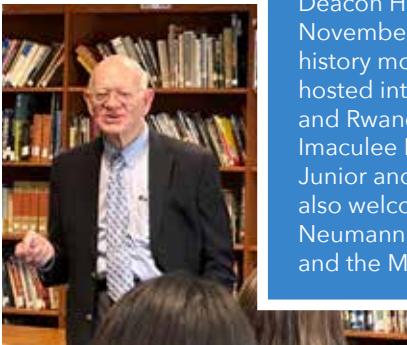




Speakers
